

What is a Medical Home?

A Medical home is all about you and your child. Coordinating and following all medical aspects of the care needed is the most important job we will do as your Medical Home. What is your part as a parent?

Bring all copies of any medical records that the child has had outside of our office. Follow the recommended well child visit schedule, making sure your child is seen at least once a year by their provider. Keep track of your child's immunizations and any other important information. Follow the recommended orders, studies, or consults for your child, as they will help us with their complete care. Ask questions if we are not clear, because we are here to help you!

What is our part as the Medical Home?

As your primary provider, we will lead the team of health care professionals that collectively take responsibility for all forms of your child's care. We will get to know you and your child and suggest treatments that make sense for your family. Keep a complete chart of your child's medical history including coordinating all notes from outside providers. Help you with obtaining appointments and giving you information for specialists, referrals, and all other resources. Help you handle your child's chronic conditions. Be available so you can bring your child in for acute sick visits the same day or the very next day. Have a nurse available by phone 24/7 for your convenience.
